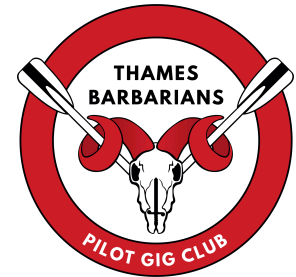




# Thames Barbarians Pilot Gig Club AGM 2022

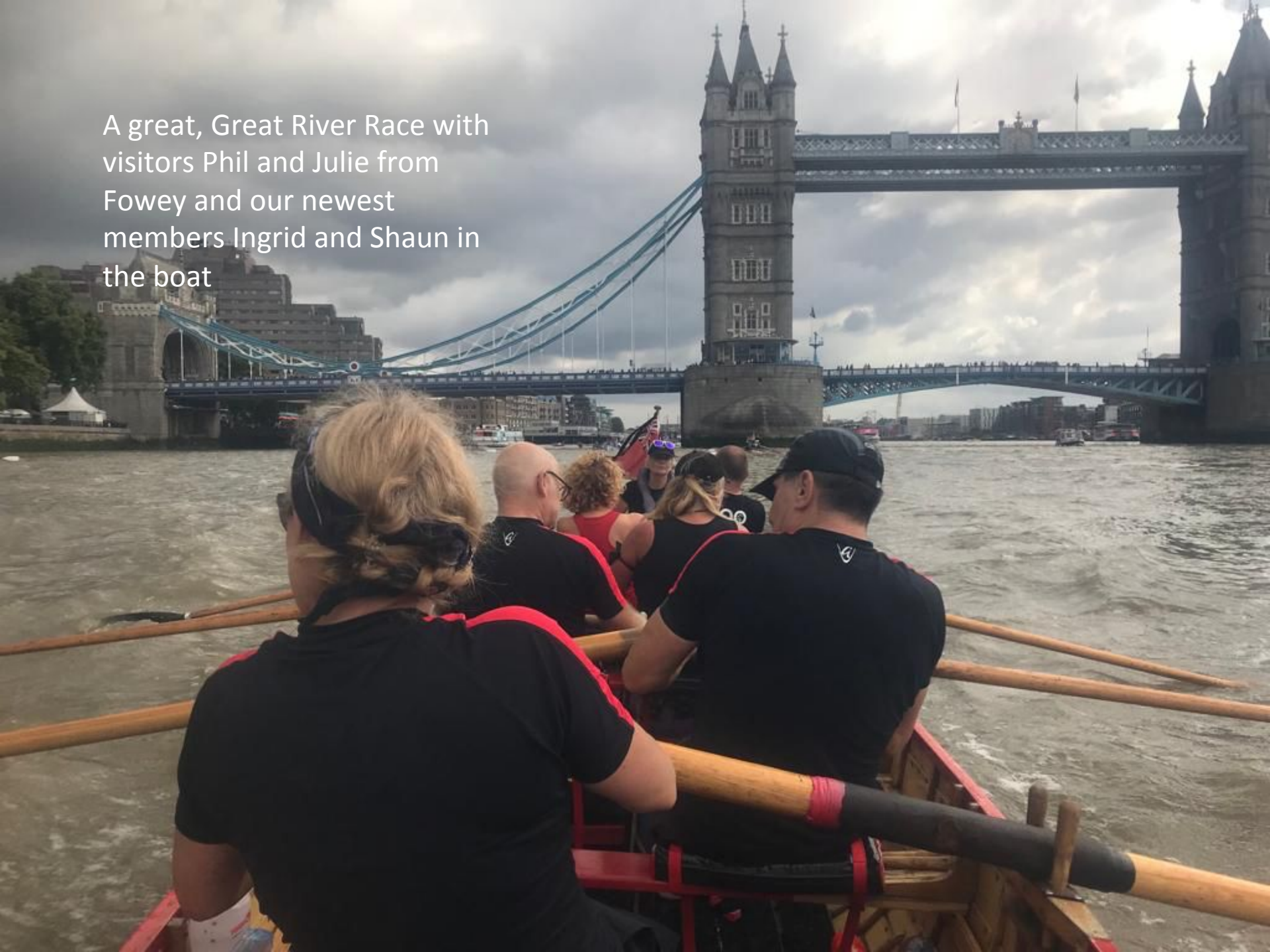

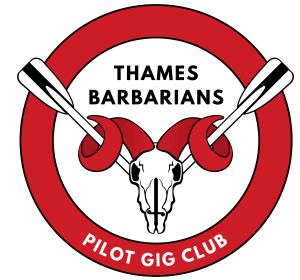

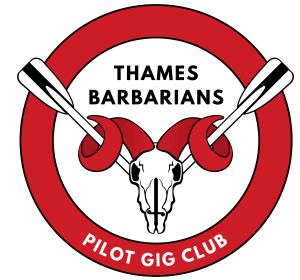
